### ENGLISH

Subjects and predicates will continue to be the focus in English class during this next week. On Wednesday, the kiddos will take a subject and predicate quiz that will cover the material up to that point. Also, we have begun our first writing assignment about the one thing they can't live without. In this assignment, we are focusing on the 6-trait of voice.

### MATH 1

We will work on comparing, ordering and rounding decimals this week as well as begin reviewing for a chapter test on Friday.

### Math 2

We will be wrapping up the chapter this week by working on dividing decimals and order of operations. Our chapter test will be next week.

### MATH 3

We will wrap up chapter 1 this week and review the concepts learned. The test will be Thursday.

### Reading

We will be finishing up Unit one this week and reviewing all of the study skills we have covered thus far. The Unit test is on Wednesday, September 9th and we will be completing the writing portion on Friday. Set 3 Vocabatoons start this week and the quiz will be Tuesday, September 15th. Reviewing for 5-10 minutes each night will really help to prevent cramming the night before.

### RELIGION

With a shortened week it will be a good time to review the server information we have been learning. The students have been asked to closely watch the altar servers at every mass so that we can be our best when it is our turn. There will be a 2nd quiz over the last 8 terms and some short answer questions on Friday, September 11th.

### SCIENCE

### SOCIAL STUDIES
