ENGLISH

Noun Town is shaping up to be quite the mystery! Be sure to ask your child about the dilemma they are trying to solve. We will continue to work on nouns. Please continue to encourage your child to study, use the quia games, and make flashcards.

MATH 1

We will begin chapter 3: multiply whole numbers. We will work with the properties of multiplication and the distributive property this week. They will have flashcards to practice for the quiz next week.

Math 2

We will continue working with solving equations and recognizing when to do which operation. We will have a quick quiz on Friday to check for understanding. We will be taking our first math vocabulary quiz next Wednesday. The students can earn 5 bonus points for making flashcards from the vocabulary on the study guides.

MATH 3

We will continue to work on chapter 3 this week by looking at multiplication properties, working with the distributive property, and problem solving by using logical reasoning. They will have flashcards to practice for next week's quiz.

Reading

We have a novel test in all classes on Tuesday, October 6th. The students are allowed to use their book and logs on the test. They will be working on novel projects in class the rest of the week. Be sure to have any materials needed

brought in by Tuesday. These projects will be due Monday, October 12th and will be presented to the class. We will start vocab again this week, Set 5, so begin reviewing these words each night.

RELIGION

We will continue working on Saint Projects in class this week. The kids should all have their flash drives at school for any opportunity they have to get work done on this. All 15 notecards are due on Friday so they may begin writing their papers. We started learning the New Testament books and will be having a quiz over the first 5 books on Wednesday.

SCIENCE

This week we will wrap up our study on Chapter 1. The chapter test is Wednesday. Bonus points will be given for flashcards made from the study guide. These flashcards have to be turned in the day before or the day of the test to receive credit. Also this week, several Creighton Medical students will be visiting us. They will provide hands-on activities and speak to us about the heart, eyes, and bone.
