ENGLISH

We will continue to explore the wonders of nouns. It is really important that we continue to study and practice the skills we are learning in class.

MATH 1 & 3:

We will continue working on chapter 3 and begin the week with a problem solving strategy – using logical reasoning. We will wrap up the week by multiplying with one-digit numbers and taking a quiz on Thursday over lessons 1-4. Friday we will look at patterns in multiples of 10.

Math 2

We will finish up our chapter this week by working with exponents and the distributive property. There will be a vocabulary quiz on Wednesday (game on quia & bonus for making flashcards) & the chapter 2 test on Friday.

Reading

This week will consist of wrapping up the novels as the kids present their projects. Those that were absent last week will obviously have a couple of extra days to get theirs finished. We will then start back in the reading textbook working on predictions, making generalizations and persuasive writing.
