### ENGLISH

This week we will begin studying a new part of speech: verbs. In our daily work we will incorporate vibrant verbs. It is important as we move onto a new part of speech to continue to review the parts of speech that we have already covered this year.

### MATH 1 & 3

We will work with the problem solving application of interpreting remainders in story problems. We will then begin reviewing for a test over division, order of operations, and problem solving on Friday.

### MATH 2

We will start the week off reviewing last weeks concepts and taking a checkpoint quiz. This week we will add and subtract mixed numbers. The kiddos will learn how to borrow to subtract.

### READING

Students in all reading classes will be working on their movie posters in class on Monday, which will be presented to the class on Wednesday. Tuesday will be the novel test for all classes. Thursday we will

begin Unit 3 covering the skill of steps in a process.

### RELIGION

We will continue practicing actions in class and students need to practice writing ALL of the New Testament Books for the Mega Test on Thursday. We will also continue with the Circle of Grace lessons this week.
